Instructions for registering for courses

- Forms must be completed using Adobe Acrobat Reader. Please do not complete the form using handwriting. This leads to issues with extracting the correct information.
- The email address submitted must be unique. It cannot be shared with anyone else including parents and siblings. The Canadian Red Cross uses your email address to establish your data record and send out your invitation to complete a profile. It will also be used by you to access your certificate.
- Fees can be submitted to our office by cheque (address on the form) along with the registration form. It is also possible to submit your completed registration form to us via email (esic@shaw.ca). It is also possible to submit your course fee via e-Transfer to esic@shaw.ca. In the comment field, please include your name and email address so that we can track backwards should that be necessary.
- Spaces in a particular course are ONLY awarded when the registration form and course fee have arrived in our office. Spaces in each course are awarded on a first come, first served basis.
- Maximum course sizes are set by Red Cross policy and may not be exceeded. Should we receive more applications for a particular course than are available, we will create a waiting list using the excess applications.
- All of courses are held in the Portables at the rear of Cambie Secondary in Richmond (4151 Jacombs Road). The school is located ½ mile north of the Richmond Auto Mall and ½ mile south of IKEA.
- Please bring a lunch or money to buy a lunch.
- The Canadian Red Cross insists that you MUST attend 100 percent of the course in order to be admitted to the final exam. If you miss part of the course, you will be moved to a future course, subject to space availability.
- We do not routinely issue refunds. If you are unable to attend a course, you must find another student to take your place and then you must arrange to recover the course fee from the replacement student.
- Please try to arrive for class a bit early so that we are not waiting for people to arrive as this delays the instructional process.
